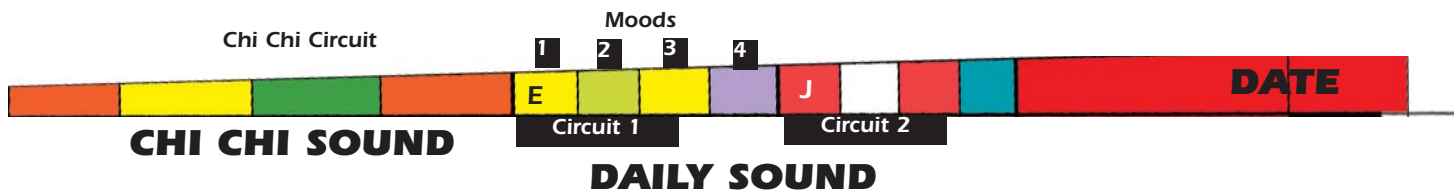


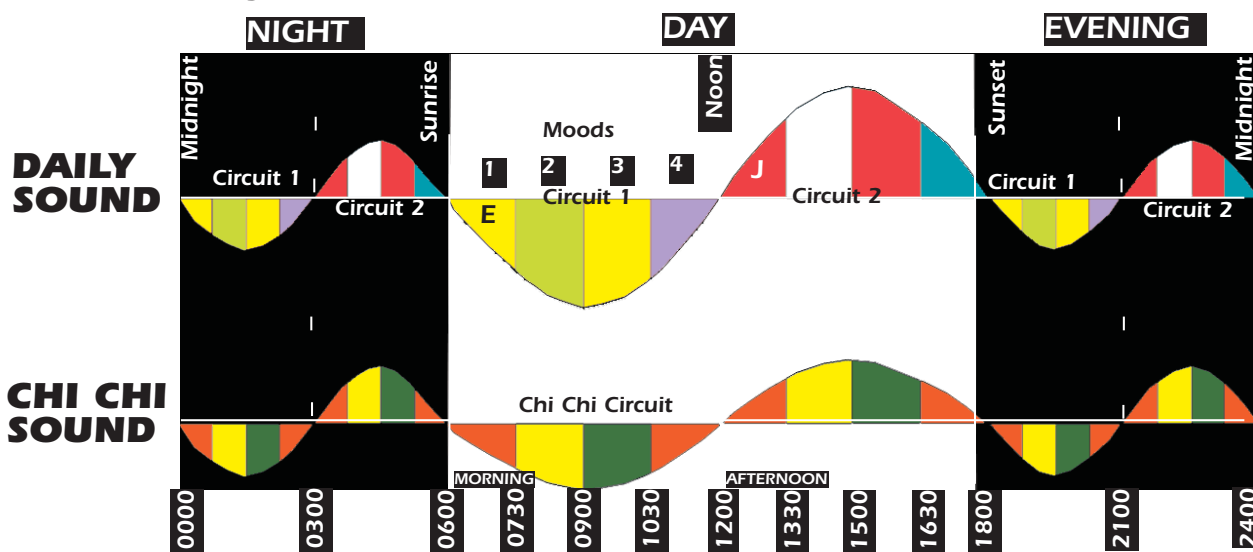
How to use the **EARTHSONG** to find the **MOOD**

EARTHSONG Calendar Key



The EARTHSONG shows the 4 moods relating to 2 circuits in our left eye and the chi chi circuits for each day of the year. The 8 moods occur 3 times and the chi chi circuits 6 times in a 24 hour period, as shown below.

MOOD Key



The Pulse's 2 components are shown in the above Mood Key as waveforms. The moods in this example are 1.5 hours during the day because there are 12 hours of daylight ($12/8=1.5$). The times at which the mood changes, are shown for both morning and afternoon circuits. These need to be adjusted for daylight saving when this is operating. The moods last for 45 minutes during the night ($12/16=0.75$). On the calendar the first mood of each circuit is also indicated by a letter which is the sound vibrated by the circuit. By finding this letter in the chi chi ring, which is in alphabetical order, you will know which 2 organs' circuits are activated on the day. The issue corresponding to those organ's moods can then be found in the centre of the EARTHSONG on the bioelectronic map of the Left Eye.

EARTHSONG Left Eye Key

The bioelectronic map in the centre of the EARTHSONG shows the template of the left eye, wrapped around a picture of a left iris. The 2 circuits in the above EARTHSONG Calendar Key and MOOD Key are indicated on the template to the right. In this instance they are circuit 1, the tongue E (truth) and circuit 2, the spinal base J (trust). The sounds are indicated by the letters. If you have a jewel or a pool in your left iris in any of the corresponding spaces, then you will have a negative experience during the time of the mood. This is because you believe in an illusion. The two tarot cards shown in the bioelectronic map, allow you to become aware of this. By allowing the illusion to be replaced with the Zen truth during the mood you will heal. Once you know truth, the lie will go.
