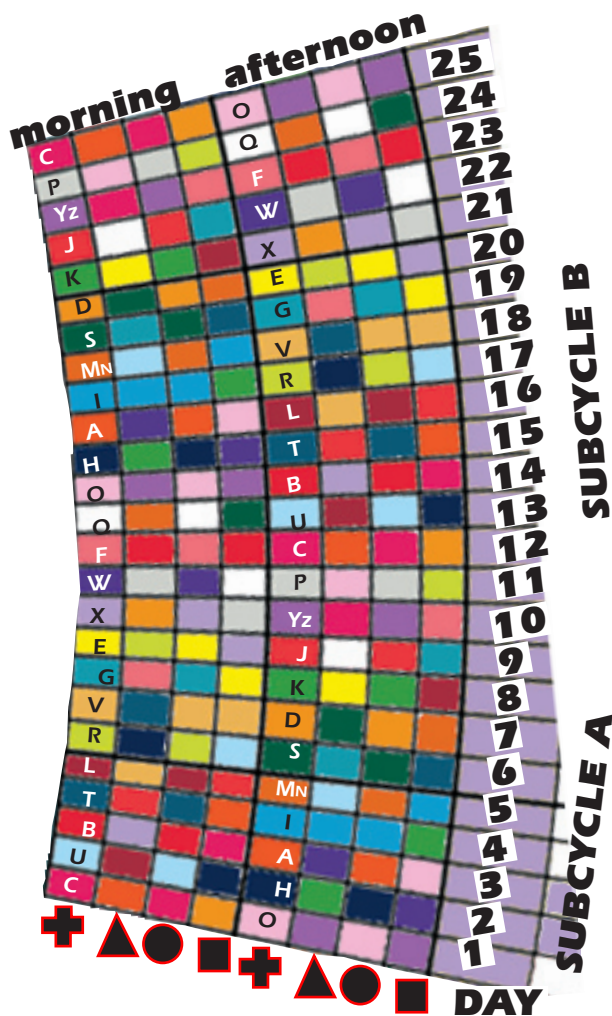
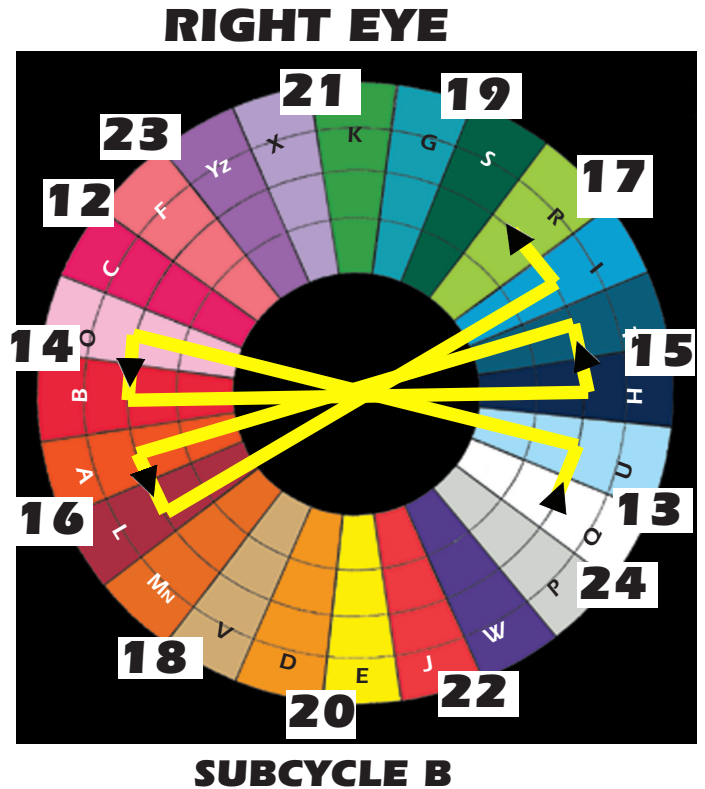
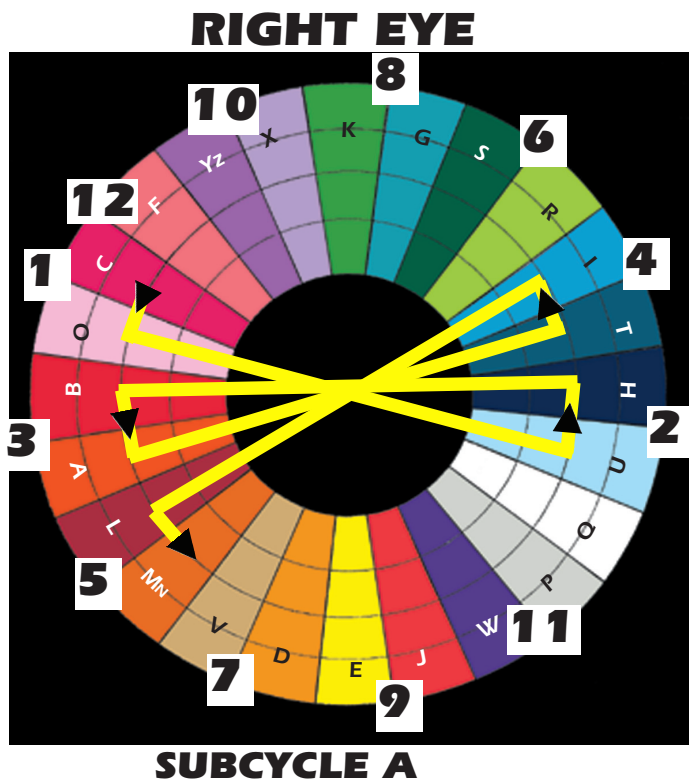


# The order of the 24 day cycle

In the **right** eye the order in which the circuits are activated by the Pulse is anti-clockwise when looking at it. Each day two adjacent organs' circuits are addressed. The next day the circuit opposite in the eye and its adjacent circuit will be active.



## For example:

**SUBCYCLE A.** DAY 1, C in the morning and O in the afternoon. DAY 2, the organ opposite to O in the eye U. U in the morning and H in the afternoon. DAY 3, B and A, DAY 4 T and I. DAY 5, L and MN and so on. Note C is in the morning on day 1 and in the afternoon on day 12.

**SUBCYCLE B.** DAY 13 Q and U. DAY 14 O and B. DAY 15 H and T and so on. Note that O is in the afternoon on day 1 and in the morning on day 14.

The same 2 circuits C and O are vibrated again on the 25th day. This arrangement results in a circuit being vibrated in the morning and then 12 days later in the afternoon.

Also a circuit will be active with a different circuit during cycles A and B. In the case of circuit C it will be active with O on day 1 and with F on day 12.

In the EARTHSONG calendar for each day there are 2 circuits shown with the morning one closest to the centre of the calendar. DAY 1 OF EACH 24 DAY CYCLE IS WHEN CIRCUITS C AND O ARE ACTIVE.
